Distribution of Scholarship Funds

Payment of scholarship will be made directly to the college, university or qualifying school and will be applied to the first and/or second semester balance for the fulltime student. Selection Criteria

Applicants will be graded by an impartial panel of qualified, anonymous judges. Applicants will be graded using the following point scale:
